

Abseil Challenge 2024 – Terms & Conditions

By joining the Abseil Challenge 2024, you certify you have read and accepted the terms and conditions for participation in this event and are aware of the following:

The activity may be physically and mentally intense.

The activity can be dangerous if I do not follow instructor's directions.

The possibility of injury to myself and others exists. As an adult I accept this risk.

I am responsible for the security of my personal belongings at all times, even if left in storage.

I am under no obligation to take part in any or all of the activities on the day and confirm and agree that:

- I am fully aware of the risks to myself, and others involved in the abseil. I can talk to the instructors regarding any concerns about what's involved before I start.
- I am physically fit and have no injuries which may affect my safety during the activities. (I understand that if I have ANY concerns about my fitness I can and will inform the instructor on the day)
- I will comply with the instructor's guidance at all times.
- I will not be under the influence of alcohol during the activity.
- I am aged 18 or over and weight no more than 120kg/18.9stone
- There is no reason medically as to why I can't take part in this event.

By taking part in the Abseil Challenge, entrants declare they are physically fit and able to participate in this event. Entrants are not aware of any medical condition or impairment that will prevent participation in this event or will affect their health by participation. Cancellation Policy.

The entry fee to participate in the Abseil Challenge is €350 (including €50 deposit which must be paid by Friday 14 March). €200 of the entry fee covers the third-party costs Debra will incur to host the challenge, and €150 will go directly to Debra to fund our programmes and services. Any cancellations received after (Friday 14 March) will result in full payment of the third-party event costs (€200) to Debra to ensure that Debra is not out-of-pocket. To participate in the event you must have paid into Debra at least €350 (including the initial €50 deposit) by no later than Friday 14 March.

I understand that the objective is to raise as much sponsorship as possible for Debra. And if I am unable to meet the minimum sponsorship requirements of €350 I, I may forfeit my place on the

Abseil Challenge by 14 March 2024, after this date I agree to cover my costs for the event that the charity incurred.

I authorise Debra to use photographs of me for promotional purposes in any type of media including website. I understand that I will not be paid for this authorisation.
